Tunbridge Wells V 6 Dartford III 0

After a few selection problems, Wells managed to put out a strong side, fielding Helen Taylor coming back after injury. From the start it was obvious that Wells should score a hatful of goals and it was only profligacy by the forwards and excellent keeping that kept the score down.

Taylor opened the scoring with a hard-hit shot into the roof of the net which put Dartford on notice for the rest of the game. Hayley Dann scored the second, lurking on the left-hand post to prod home a mis-hit shot by Denise Holme. In the second half Dann scored a second, but from a more controlled cross. Holme scored one for herself when a decent shot was helped into the goal by a defender under pressure from Saria Howkins.

Taylor, whose hitting power cowed Dartford, claimed a hat-trick. One of her goals came directly from a short corner, the other from an equally hard hit cracked in from the right.
